The East Bohemian Museum in Pardubice, in cooperation with the Department of Archaeology at the University of Hradec Králové and the Institute of Archaeology and Museology at Masaryk University, would like to invite you to a newly prepared conference. The theme of the conference will be "Archaeology of linear structures - application of natural science methods and information technologies; their procedures, results and interpretation"

Due to the ever increasing number of large-scale (mainly) linear rescue investigations, and the increasing number of collaborations with the natural and chemical-physical sciences (including IT technologies), we would like to hold a conference where the primary space will be dedicated to preliminary or even final results from such data. The purpose is to present and expand the general awareness of the necessity of interdisciplinary cooperation in large-scale archaeological excavations, as well as their use in subsequent professional processing.

We welcome all annotated presentations (15 minutes) and posters whose unifying theme is the archaeology of linear structures using primarily methods and analyses in the field of:

- Natural Sciences (Bioarchaeology etc.)
- Chemistry and Physics, Geophysics
- Technology (IT; 3D scanning etc.)
- etc.

The conference will take place in the pleasant surroundings of the Renaissance castle in Pardubice from 4 to 6 June 2024, and will include a social evening and excursions. The output will be a special dedicated issue of Studia Archaeologica Brunensia ISSN: 1805-918X (print), ISSN: 2336-4505 (online).
